New Executive Board for Phoenix Contact E-Mobility in Schieder-Schwalenberg

(01/19) Michael Heinemann and Ralf Döhre took over the leadership of Phoenix Contact E-Mobility GmbH at the beginning of the year. Michael Heinemann is the CEO and Chairman of the Executive Board, and Ralf Döhre is the COO of the company that is based in Schieder-Schwalenberg.

At the end of 2018, Mr. Heinemann completed his fifth year as the Chief Executive Officer of the Phoenix Contact Power Supplies subsidiary, which is based in Paderborn. He began his career at Phoenix Contact in 1992, and in 2012 moved from managing product marketing for the Power Supplies unit to the board of the then-subsiary APtronic AG in Bad Sassendorf, which in turn became part of the Power Supplies business unit at the Paderborn facility in 2014.

Ralf Döhre has been working for the Phoenix Contact Group since 2007. He took over responsibility for international production in China, India and the USA in the Device Connectors business unit in 2009. Ralf Döhre has been a part of the E-Mobility GmbH management team since 2013. He was instrumental in developing the company in his roles as both the Commercial Director and Production Manager.

The current General Manager of E-Mobility GmbH, Oliver K. Stöckl, will be leaving Phoenix Contact at the end of February for family reasons, and will take on a new role in Southern Germany.

Phoenix Contact Power Supplies GmbH in Paderborn will now be led by Georg Beretitsch as the Chief Executive Officer; Mr. Beretitsch has been a Member of the Management Board of this company since 2015. He has been with Phoenix Contact since 1994 and, in roles responsible for quality management and production, has coordinated the new location in Bad Pyrmont as well as the company-wide network for electronics production.
