1. Introduction

The Open Catalog Interface (OCI) is an interface first specified by SAP AG in the nineties for the exchange of shopping carts between SAP systems and any other catalogs.

We support the OCI protocol from version 4.0, as well as some functions of the protocol in version 5.0. Details can be found in the protocol specification ¹.

The functional enhancements of the OCI standard, which were supplemented by version 5.0 of the OCI protocol, are not currently supported. These are:

1. Detailed Display of a Product or Service
2. Validation of a Product
3. Sourcing/Product Search
4. Background Search

1. Configuration in the calling system

Please create the external catalog in your system in compliance with the following information:

1. Please pay attention to the spelling of the parameter names (e.B. username instead of USERNAME)
2. Please pay attention to the correct structure of the url
3. Depending on your environment, additional parameters may have to be set.

Parameter: USERNAME

The OCI username provided to you by us

Parameter: PASSWORD

The OCI password provided to you by us

Parameter: HOOK_URL

Generated automatically by your system, usually "SAPEVENT:POST"
